### Entrance Scholarship Guidelines

- This Scholarship is limited to new students enrolling a degree program offered at Virginia University of Oriental Medicine.
- This Scholarship amount is \$500 and is awarded up to 5 new students per Quarter.
- The fund is applied to tuition expenses only and applied to student's account before the instruction begins.
- The awardee must be enrolled as a full time student for the first Quarter of instruction at VUOM.
- The award decisions are determined and granted by the VUOM Scholarship Committee
- The application due date is 2 weeks before the new Quarter begins.
